Ukrainian, Polish generals discuss use of foreign weapons

Commander of the Ukrainian Joint Forces, Lieutenant General Serhiy Naiev and Operational Commander of the Polish Armed Forces, Lieutenant General Tomasz Piotrowski have discussed the use of various types of foreign weapons.

The press service of the Joint Forces Command reported this on <u>Telegram</u>, according to Ukrinform.

Both parties also discussed promising areas of bilateral cooperation, the security situation in the region, and ways of providing assistance to Ukraine in repelling Russia's armed aggression.

During the discussion, having considered a set of issues related to possible challenges and threats due to the deployment of Wagner Group fighters in Belarus, Naiev emphasized the importance of continuing the exchange of information and experience of organizing combat work at command posts.

Furthermore, he shared the peculiarities of the practical application of various types of foreign weapons and stressed the need for additional training of subordinate personnel in the operation and repair of Polish-made military equipment.

Piotrowski supported this initiative and expressed respect for Ukraine's courageous struggle against Russia. He also added that Poland would provide constant and comprehensive support to Ukraine.

Naiev thanked his Polish counterpart for significant assistance to Ukraine in defending its independence and freedom.

"The Republic of Poland provides powerful support to Ukraine's defense capabilities, which is a significant and undeniable contribution to the victory over the aggressor," the commander said.
